






To go to bed = <u>acostarse</u>	<i>put oneself to bed</i>	Se acuesta
To fall asleep = <u>dormirse</u>	<i>oneself falls asleep</i>	Se duerme
To wake oneself up = <u>despertarse</u>	<i>oneself wakes up</i>	Se despierta
<i>cara = face</i>	<i>Te duele la cara?</i>	<i>porque me está matando.</i>
To wash oneself = <u>lavarse</u>	se lava	
Ella lava mis pies		
<u>Ella</u> me lava los pies.		
To shave oneself = <u>afeitarse</u>	se afeita	
<u>Ella</u> me afeita la barba		
<i>navaja = razor</i>	<i>las piernas</i>	
<i>crema de afeitar = shaving cream</i>		
To take a shower = <u>tomar una ducha</u>		
To shower oneself = <u>ducharse</u>	se ducha	
	<i>ducharme = to shower myself</i>	
To wash one's hair = <u>lavarse el pelo</u>		
<u>Ella</u> me lava el pelo		
To bathe oneself = <u>bañarse</u>	se baña	
To brush one's teeth = <u>Cepillarse</u>	se cepilla	
	<i>los dientes</i>	
To make oneself up = <u>maquillarse</u>		
To put on make up = <u>ponerse la maquilla</u>	se maquilla	
<i>peine = comb</i>		
To comb oneself = <u>peinarse</u>	se peina	
To look at oneself = <u>mirarse</u>	<i>espejo = mirror</i>	se mira
To put clothing on oneself = <u>ponerse la ropa</u>		
To dress oneself = <u>vestirse</u>	<u>Se</u> viste	
¿Tú <u>la</u> viste? = You saw her?		
	<i>me nos te os la/lo los/los</i>	
¿Se viste usted? = You dress yourself?		
¿Me viste? = You saw me?	<i>you (usted) dress me?</i>	
To sit down = <u>Sentarse</u>	se sienta	

Don't be so quick to conjugate
REFLEXIVE
VERBS!

Paso 1: To conjugate reflexive verbs you take the "se"
levantarse

Paso 2: Then you put it in your pocket *levantar*  and you conjugate *levantas*

Paso 3: When you're done with that then you take the pronoun out *levantas*  and you turn it around *te!* 

and you put it in the front.
te levantas
